

### **Steel Challenge specifics and Guidelines for Range 2 use.**

Spring and Summer Steel Challenge (SC) Leagues at HRGAC will consist of 4 separate 5 week Leagues with the 5th week being a makeup night for up to 2 missed days of shooting.

All Spring and Summer league competition will be only on Monday nights starting at 5 PM.

SC league fees are as follows and are due prior to the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of shooting.

Fee for Club members is \$30 basic fee for 1 gun and \$10 for each additional gun.

Fee for Non Club members is \$70 basic fee for 1 gun and \$10 for each additional gun.

Non Club members participating will be required to sign the liability Waiver nightly.

### **League Schedule is as follows:**

Spring Rimfire starts April 3<sup>rd</sup> with makeup on May 1<sup>st</sup>.

Spring Centerfire starts May 8<sup>th</sup> with makeup on June 12<sup>th</sup>.

Summer Rimfire starts June 19<sup>th</sup> with makeup on July 17<sup>th</sup>.

Summer Centerfire starts July 24<sup>th</sup> with makeup on August 21<sup>st</sup>.

22 Rimfire semi auto pistols and rifles only for Rimfire leagues

Centerfire semi auto Pistols and Pistol Caliber Carbines in 9mm but 38 and 45 can be used.

No other calibers can be used on the plates on Range 1 or 2.

5 mags or mags of sufficient capacity to complete 5 strings without reloading are required.

Chamber flags, ear and eye protection are mandatory.

### **Range 2 use is limited to participants in the SC Leagues.**

Current SC League participants may practice during open club hours for the daily use fee having presented your current SC league fee receipt to the bartender.

All Safety procedures apply to Steel Challenge/Range 2 use whether during League operation or practice. No Exceptions

Range 2 cannot be used by non Steel Challenge participants unless accompanied by a RSO or current league participant and familiarized with SC Range Protocol.

Range 2 cannot be used as an overflow for Range 1 when full or off limits for CCW activities.

**The above restrictions on Range 2 use are due to the very different Safety protocols in addition to the posted HRGAC safety rules. Please see the HRGAC Steel Challenge Rules.**
